America from my shoes.

We are all born equal regardless of race, sex or who our parents may be, we each start out the same with nothing. Our environment develops the characters we become with good or bad results. The paths we travel gives us success or failure, by the standard society sets to measure the value of the individual. Among the rich this measure is money. The educated measure it by the degree one holds. The Religious by one's dedication to the church. The average by the job they do. The poor by the place to live and food to eat. All of these have one thing in common they all make up this great nation called America.

Yes this is the great measure of the value of the people of this nation. We all strive to excell in this great nation, by climbing the ladder of success, prosperity and promise. But few of us born at the bottem ever get the chance to achieve success after society draws its conclusions of the individual's abilities, talents and knowledge. Those of the social elite consider themselves the foremost authority on the value of people and once stereo typed, that is the class where you belong. Many are stuck in a class beneath their ambitions and society is quick to put them in their place if they try to raise above their appointed station.

America has become a mirror of the British with ranks and measures according to the beliefs of the powers that be. There are two distinct classifications that openly operate our nation these are the haves and the have nots. Among the rich they openly discriminate against the poor. Among the educated, you are considered stupid if you don't hold a degree. Among the average you are trash if you don't have a good job. The poor are looked down upon by all of these. This is the way life is and we all are brain washed into accepting this standard as the status quo of our American Society.

Lets consider for a moment that all Americans are born equal and all are given equal opportunity to excell. Everyone would have the same income, the same education the same social status, we would all believe the same things, accept the same truths and no one would be an individual, we would all be accepted as a member of the group called Americans. This would be a mondan society, one where no one would fail or attempt anything new. We could not grow or excell in anything outside the common practice and all innovation would be opposed by all. This would not be America, we are the melting pot of all cultures and our efforts to improve the world have brought us into this era of technology. Its too bad our social skills have not developed at the same pace.

America is supposed to be a "Republic", but we all know this isn't true. In a "Republic" every voice is heard and respected. Within our modern government, the only voices heard are those of "Corporations" and "Lobbiat" who pay our "Representatives" to do their bidding. In return for the "silver" they receive, our "Representatives" pass laws to benefit the few by taxing or penalizing the majority. They call it "Democracy" whereby the people are represented by "Representatives" who vote for the majority of the people and the majority of these votes determine our laws. One "Representative" represents millions of people. Since the majority of our "Representatives" are members of the [BAR] (British Accredited Registry) the interest of the BAR is the determination of the laws that govern us. Unless you have money or are a member of the BAR, you have no voice in government. I believe government serves these interests, not the interest of the American People.

What is law? Law has but two purposes in our society the first is to protect the people, the second is to protect their property. These laws are the only true laws of American Society. "Common law" dictates that unless there is injury to person or damage to property, established by an "injured party", there can be no criminal intent. Our law is limited to these two cases, whether Civil or Criminal, only these are lawfully allowed. But these limitations have been exceeded by

BAR members, who can not profit from our law. They have united in conspiracy to create, "imposter law" where no "injured party" is necessary. The law of modern America is for one purpose to benefit the BAR or a "Corporation" at the expense of one of the people or all of them as taxpayers. Possession of marijuana in Missouri will get you 5 years mandatory. This allows BAR members to "extort" large defense fees for litigating this imposter crime. Like wise, is the imposter law, that requires us to have "auto insurance". Insurance Corporations have raised their rates to "extort" large premiums from the people to meet this unlawful obligation. Of course those who live in bad areas pay more than those who live in rich neighborhoods. Those who have the least pay the most. Of course if you are caught driving without insurance, you are subject to large fines by the courts for failing to meet Corporate demands. There are thousands of imposter laws in our American Society, just like these. These laws benefit Corporations and BAR members at the expense of the people. I believe in "Common law" that says if there is no "injured party" there is no crime for which punishment can be assessed.

This brings us to our Courts. Our Judges represent each and everyone of us and it is their job to act impartially and deal with each of us fairly. Anyone who has ever been to Court, of the lower classes, will tell you this is not the

case. If you can afford to hire an attorney you might get justice, if you don't you are sure not to get justice. Court has become a profit institution of the BAR and no-one but BAR members are allowed to litigate any case. The judge prosecutor and defense attorney are all BAR members of the "British Accredited Registry" and they alone dictate what law is applied. Every judge is lawfully required to have an "Oath of Office" under 28 USC 453, but the vast majority do not have this oath. BAR members, acting as "foreign agents" 22 USC 611 have "pirated" our courts and are acting as "Public Officials" of "Judge" without authority of law to do as they please. They ignore all facts, law and evidence to create injustice in our courts. This is done because there is no one above them except other BAR members who always find no criminal conduct is present, without any investigation inquiry or evidence being examined. BAR members are always right, the rest of us are always wrong. When judges violate our law and stand together against the constitutions, can we really trust them to determine our disputes. [BAR] policy always prevails over constitutional rights or the opinions of the people.

For almost 20 years I have fought to achieve one goal to have the Constitution upheld in any Court of America. In over 100 cases, filed for myself and my friends, not once has the Constitution been supported, accepted or upheld. It has been

denied, dismissed, rejected, ignored and reeled against every single time. This tells me it is not the law, facts and evidence that determines justice, but rather who is presenting them. BAR members are always right, non BAR members are always wrong. A rich man is usually found innocent of his crimes and the poor man is usually found guilty. BAR members only allow justice to those who can pay and the injustices done to the poor are ignored. After all they don't matter, only the socially acceptable are entitled to the protection of law, because they can buy it from the BAR by paying the fees. The poor must accept their fate they are not among the chosen few and have no rights, no privileges and no immunities, those are reserved to the upper class. All the rest of us can present all the law in the world and never prevail.

As I sit in this prison cell, I ask what authority of law holds me? The Revised Statutes of Missouri 1.210 says no person will be restrained or detained without authority of law. But the BAR and all its members have determined Denny Ray Hardin should be in prison and thus BAR policy is superior to our law, regardless of what the written law says. To convict me of an imposter crime the BAR allowed violations of the 1st, 4th, 5th, 6th, 9th and 11th Amendments. All the BAR members agree this is acceptable conduct, because the end justifies the means. Denny Ray Hardin is a convict and in

prison. Of course the Appeals Courts of the Missouri Supreme Court and the Federal District Courts, made up of BAR members will not enforce the law, because Denny Ray Hardin is not rich and won't pay for their loyalty, so they all remain silent and allow the unlawful detention to continue. I ask, wasn't the unlawful conduct of judges one of the reasons for the American Revolutionary War? The same "British" practices of the 1700s are present in America today. Only the socially elite are allowed justice in our courts.

To stop these corrupt Public Officials, I have filed criminal complaints with the United States Department of Justice. These have been posted on this website for all to read. Of course, this Department of government is controlled by the BAR and the crimes of "Piracy", "Kidnapping", "Deprivation of rights under color of law", "Conspiracy against rights", "Obstruction of Justice", "Peonage", "Fraud" among others have been formally presented and ignored by the United States Attorney General. If one of us committed one of these crimes against a BAR member we would be in jail in a matter of hours. But today in America, these crimes are the common practice of BAR members against the people. 42 USC 1981 gives every American the right to give evidence, but the BAR policy is they don't have to prosecute. The BAR simply ignores the laws violated and condones all criminal acts of any BAR member in good

standing. Of course, this is "Treason", "Seditious Conspiracy", "Conspiracy to overthrow government" and "Misprision of Felonies" but again who will prosecute? I could present the facts, law and evidence that clearly shows these crimes by the President, Secretary of State and Attorney General, all BAR members, but as usual the BAR policy not to prosecute BAR members for their crimes would prevail. So we as Americans have no lawful means of holding BAR members accountable for their crimes. All Public Officials are paid by Americans' tax dollars yet no American can get any public servant to do their job properly. We Americans have no say in the conduct of the government, our only purpose is to pay their salaries, medical insurance and retirement funds, for them to continue to violate our law. The redman, yellowman and blackman have been fighting this for generations, I am white and believe it is time we all stood together in opposition of the BAR, and the criminals who operate it against us. Wasn't taxation without representation a reason for the American Revolutionary War? I ask what is the difference between the British government of the 1700s and the American government of today? Instead of 13 governors, we have 50 operating the same corruption. My government tells me, I am accountable to the law, but the BAR is not. Because I openly oppose this corruption, I am labeled "anti government". I say every member of the BAR, is "anti American".

So I sit in prison as a "bonded slave" of the BAR and a corrupt government. I have learned I have no rights, no privileges and no immunities, but most importantly I have no representation in government to protect me or come to my aid. I support the Constitution and laws made in support of it. I openly oppose the [British] and all its "agents" in America. To remove my creditability I have been fraudulently labeled a criminal, a violent criminal, a drug dealer, a paper terrorist and anti government. This is done, by the BAR, in the hopes I will not be supported in my efforts to restore our Constitution and stop the corruption of the BAR, by the other classes of Americans. As an American of the poor class, I only have the power to speak the truth, communicate it in writing and hope other honorable Americans will see its merits. If the socially elite would just make inquiries, to those responsible to act within the government, I would be free.

I lay down my pen with a heavy heart, knowing I am right, but accepting every BAR member opposes, oppresses and discriminates against me because I am not a member of the elite. I am not a BAR member, I am not a Corporation, I am not rich, I am not entitled to protection of law, I am just an American who believes in the morals, ethics and principles this nation was founded upon. One of those forefathers said Tyranny can only exist where honorable

men do nothing. I believe the [British] have over thrown
our government and it is controlled by the [BAR]. The
next time you think you live in a free country,
think again, you live in a dictatorship and the BAR
is your master. As long as the BAR controls our
government, Americans will never be free. I say give
me liberty or give me death.
