ORDER

On May 14, 2010, I ordered that Defendant be committed to a United States Medical Center for Federal Prisoners to undergo a psychological examination. The order stated that Defendant's commitment was not to "exceed 30 days unless that time is extended for an additional period of time not to exceed 15 days upon a showing of good cause that the additional time is necessary to observe and evaluate defendant." Defendant arrived at the Federal Medical Center on May 28, 2010. I received a letter dated June 10, 2010, from the Federal Bureau of Prisons requesting an additional time to complete Defendant's evaluation. It is hereby

ORDERED that the Federal Bureau of Prisons' request is granted. Defendant's commitment to the United States Medical Center for Federal Prisoners shall not exceed 45 days from the date of his arrival.
