Hey Babe,

Well, the letter to the President went out again today. I wonder if they will return it again. The first time they returned it, say I could not use the back side of forms for writing paper, so I re-wrote it, twice yesterday. One for the President and one I sent to christina to be put on the website.

"Let's talk about Prisons"

This is the "WRDCC" which stands for "We really don't care convict". Its purpose is to remove the convict from all outside family, friends and thinking, and establish government domination of an individual. This is why convicts are only allowed one visit here after 30 days. By then most feel cut off from the world and isolated, then government steps up and says see we are nice people you can see your family now. This is the game of "tear down", "destroy" then "rebuild" and "remold" all into "loaners". This system is destroying America's families, by creating individuals who don't give a fuck about anything. I see them all around me. For example the guy under me is 22 and his girl is getting ready to have his baby, any day now. The

Judge would not let h'im wait until after the baby was born to start his 120 days. Will he feel guilty, about that for the rest of his life of course he will. The Judge has demonstrated his ability to play god in people's lives. He cost this young couple the most precious moment they could share in their lives the birth of their child. The Judge wins government wins, the rest always loose,

Now lets talk about who profits from this system, Well prisons are built by Judges, lawyers, corporations, Sheriff's and Politicians who use public money to build the facility. Then, these individuals sit on the Board of Directors, who share the profits, And operation of prisons, is big business. Every prisoner is worth about \$35,000 to the prison, if they can get them out and back in, in the same year, that is another \$35,000. This accounts for the fact about 90% of those on parole are violated and sent back, for prison profit.

A prison is built in a rude community where jobs are scarce and soon employes a large number of the local population, as guards clerical and medical. The majority of the labor is performed by convicts, who are

paid way below minimum wage to perform the operations of the facilities. It is considered a privilege to have a job in prison. The food is abtous, but it looks good on the state menu that is not followed. The food is a combination of grawl, beans and rice, every now an then a meal on the menu is thrown in, just for show. The food will keep you alive, if you can stand to eat it.

Guards are local people who are mostly on a power trip, that they must be obeyed by all. There are 80 guys in my ~~unit~~ unit with 2 guards that rotate 24 hours a day. Every guard is an individual and all have their pet peives. Some are descent people others are assholes, just like in the free world. But you would think 80 convicts, who were not decent people, by their interpretation, could not be controled by two guards. These guards are paid to cause inmates to snap, crack or lash out. Their tools are write ups, denial of bathroom use except certain times and an "OFFENDER RULEBOOK to charge infractions of their law. There is a camera that monitors the bay, but it is not a safe environment by any standard.

Prison is the "Board of Probation & Parole" enforcement. They are the source of convicts for the prison. Consider them "Human Resourcing". In my situation I refused to pay "Intervention fees" because I consider them to be "Extortion Money". Pay or you go to prison was the threat of my Probation Officer for three years. Over three years these fees have added up to \$576.00. My girl put \$200.00 on my books and \$195.00 was unlawfully seized in violation of the 4th Amendment without any due process. P & P will get their money one way or another all must pay their ~~mannon~~ mannon. I refused to pay, but this is a common violation that sends those back to prison. In this economy, some can't afford to pay. Like slavery, "Debtor's Prisons" have returned.

This gives you a pretty good insight into how a prison operates. Government officials unlawful using "Tax Dollars" to "Profit" them personally. The State of Missouri only has "Public Money" and none can lawfully be given to any corporation. That is a violation of Article VI Section 23a of the Constitution of Missouri. This "revolving door system" operated by "White Collar Criminals" is "organized crime" to steal "Tax Dollars" from the people of Missouri.

If local governments were forced to pay these costs them selves, the number of individuals sent to prison would drop to a trickle. As long as it is profitable to send people to prison, lawyers, judges and politicians are going to engage in "Bonding Slaves" into peonage. Common law dictates unless there is injury to person or damage to property there can be no criminal intent established. Only about 10% in my b99 are true criminals, the rest are railroaded for the profit of this facility. Who profits from this ~~organized~~ organized crime? Lawyer, judges, prisons politicians, probation officers, small communities get jobs and they all receive tax dollars. As long as this is possible, the government will continue to create "Imposter Laws" to provide body for that \$35,000 housing fee of a convict.

I ask is this what "American Tax Payers" want done with their "Tax Dollars" creating criminals for Profit of government? Since this is true in missouri, it must be true in your state as well. I say when it is no longer profitable to government, crime will be decreased to criminals, Innocents will no longer be railroaded for profit. Denny R. Hard
