Subject: "Slavery in America"

Dear Mr. President:

Please forgive the crudity of this letter, I am but a "slave" being traded by the "STATE OF MISSOURI" in violation of 18 USC 1590. I am currently being held aboard a "Public Vessel for Slave Trade" as defined in 18 USC 1582, along with millions of other Americans. Therefore, Please judge my letter by its content and not by its delivery. I am utilizing what resources are available to me to inform you of my plite.

I look around me and see a hundred other slaves, who like me have been cast into peonage and who unlike me do not possess the knowledge to condemn that which is being done to them. The difference is I know "seizure, detention, transportation or sale of slaves" is unlawful

and a violation of 18 USC 1585. They know it is wrong, I know why it is wrong. They like your ancestors, are helpless to fight the forces who "traffic in slavery" 18 USC 1590. I bring this matter before my president for enforcement of our laws.

The trial of Denny R. Hardin was held on August 12, 2009, in the "Corporate Court of Jackson County, Missouri". This mock trial was held by W. Stephen Nixon and other "Foreign Agents" 22 USC 611 and openly violated my rights before the 20 witnesses present. "Trial by Jury" was requested and ignored as evidenced by the court's record. Mr Nixon refused all facts, all law and all evidence then pronounced me guilty and sentenced me to 5 years in prison. This is clearly "Enticement into Slavery" 18 USC 1583 and "Conspiracy against rights" 18 USC 241.

After seeing all the violations of law, clearly on the transcript of this case, the witnesses present witnessed Denny R. Hardin being hand cuffed and taken to the Jackson county Jail. On August 13, 2009, I was transported to this "Public Vessel for Slave Trade" 18 USC 1582. Without any due process of law required by the 5th and 6th Amendments without findings of facts and conclusions of law

required in writing by 5 USC 557(c)(3), RSMo 536.090, Denny R. Hardin now sits in prison.

The Kansas City Star presented W. Stephen Nixon as the judge who stopped Denny R Hardin (a private banker). The Kansas City Star has always been a puppet of Jackson County to present its frauds upon demand. To this "rag" the details do not matter, they don't care how they play the game, just so they can win in the Public eye. The people should forget, Denny Hardin was denied Trial by Jury (5th Amendment), The People should forget, Denny Hardin was denied witness for his defense (6th Amendment). Oh they don't have to forget, because they were not told the truth in the first Place. All they need to know is Denny Hardin is in prison.

A "Notice of Appeal" was filed in Jackson County on August 14th 2009, to the Missouri Supreme Court for validation of the Constitutions. The Missouri Rules of criminal Procedure Rule 30.16 "Release pending Appeal" requires all to be given "Bond" for Appeal except where the punishment is "Death" or "life in prison". I guess this means everybody except Denny Hardin, bond has been denied to date, "Habeas Corpus" has been refused as well, by warden Burgess. This clear "Discrimination" is "common practice" where Denny Hardin is concerned.

I believe, I can truly understand, how my hero Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. felt sitting in the Birmingham Jail writing to John F. Kennedy, Jr. He was lucky a man of honor came to his aid. Only time can tell if the same is true for me. I am a "Private Banker" who has not been dishonored. I am an "American Citizen" who has clean hands, who has not injured anyone or damaged any property. Yet I sit in Prison based upon "Imposter Law" that claims authority to violate the constitutions, held me without any authority of law in violation of RSMo 1.210. This law says no person shall be held or restrained without authority of law. Again everybody except Denny Hardin, it is OK to "Discriminate" against him.

In conclusion, I can only hope that I will be given the "Due Process of law" secured by the "Supreme Law of the land" to all "American Citizens". When "Americans" are violated to preserve violations of law, preserve profits for Corporations and allow "Foreign Agents" to deny due process of law. Then I am justified in the "Condemnation" of the "UNITED STATES OF AMERICA". Mr. President, if you will not do your job, perhaps the "International Court of Justice" will do theirs. I present my delima to the honorable men of the world and hope they will come to my aid. God's will be done.
