ORDER

Before the court are the government's motion for a detention hearing and motion to continue the hearing for three days. Title 18, United States Code, Section 3142(f)(2)(B) provides that, upon motion by the attorney for the government, the judicial officer shall conduct a detention hearing in a case that involves a serious risk that the person will obstruct or attempt to obstruct justice. In this case, Defendant is alleged to have continued his actions despite being told directly by state and federal law enforcement activities that such actions were unlawful. Defendant's website contains statements that he will continue his fraud scheme upon release and that his ultimate goal is to overthrow the United States government. Based on these allegations, I find that there is a serious risk that Defendant will obstruct or attempt to obstruct justice if not detained.

Therefore, it is

ORDERED that, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3142(f)(2), the government's motion for a detention hearing is granted. It is further

ORDERED that the government's motion to continue the hearing for three days is granted.

It is further

ORDERED that a detention hearing is set for 1:30 p.m., Thursday, May 13, 2010.
